1 SEC. 3. Any person who shall secure the use of a telephone party  
 2 line or public pay telephone by falsely stating that such line or phone  
 3 is needed for an emergency call shall be fined not exceeding one hun-  
 4 dred dollars, or be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding thirty  
 5 days.

1 SEC. 4. Every telephone company doing business in this state shall  
 2 print a copy of sections one (1) to three (3) of this Act in a promi-  
 3 nent place in every telephone directory published by it after July 4,  
 4 1959. Any person, firm, or corporation providing telephone service  
 5 which distributes or causes to be distributed in this state copies of a  
 6 telephone directory which is subject to the provisions of this section  
 7 which does not contain the notice herein provided for shall be fined  
 8 not exceeding one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the county jail  
 9 not exceeding thirty days.

### INJURIES TO DOGS

H. F. 329

AN ACT relating to injuries to animals.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seven hundred seventeen point one (717.1),  
 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking in line (3) the word "beast"  
 3 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "animal or dog".

## CHAPTER 370

### LABOR ORGANIZATION DUES

H. F. 116

AN ACT relating to labor organization dues.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seven hundred thirty-six A point five  
 2 (736A.5), Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking from lines eight  
 3 (8), nine (9) and ten (10) the following: "and by his or her spouse,  
 4 if married, in the manner set forth in section 539.4,".
