LEGAL COUNSEL IN FELONY CASES

H. F. 33

AN ACT to require that every person indicted for a felony be represented by legal counsel before a plea of guilty or entry of judgment is made.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section seven hundred seventy-seven point twelve (777.12), Code 1958, is hereby amended as follows:

1. By inserting in line three (3) of such section after the word, "himself," the words, "and in the presence of legal counsel acting on behalf of the defendant if the defendant is charged with a felony".

2. By inserting in line nine (9) after the period (.) the words, "Before a plea of guilty or an entry of judgment, if the defendant has neither employed counsel nor been assigned counsel as provided in section seven hundred seventy-five point four (775.4) of the Code, the court shall appoint counsel for the defendant if the defendant is
