CHAPTER 8.

RECORDS OF BENTON COUNTY.

AN ACT authorizing the county Judge of Benton county, Iowa, to transcribe the records of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the county Judge of Benton county, ^{County judge.} in the State of Iowa, be, and is hereby authorized to trans-^{Transcribe re-}cribe all records of said county which in his opinion the in-^{records.}terests of the county demands, the county paying the ex-^{Expenses.}penses of the same.

SEC. 2. This act to be in force from and after its publi-^{Take effect.}cation in the Vinton Eagle and Iowa City Republican.

CHAPTER 9.

VACATING STATE ROAD IN PRIMROSE.

AN ACT to vacate a part of a State road in the town of Primrose, in the county of Lee.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State road.* *State of Iowa,* That so much of the State road leading ^{Primrose.} from Charleston to Fairfield, as crosses any of the town lots in Primrose, be, and the same is hereby vacated. ^{Vacated.}

SEC. 2 This act to take effect and be in force from and ^{Take effect.}after its passage.
