

## CHAPTER 63.

## ADDITIONAL JUSTICE OF THE PEACE.

AN ACT for an additional Justice of the Peace, of Columbia township, Wapello county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the* <sup>Election.</sup> *State of Iowa,* That the electors of Columbia township, in Wapello county, be authorized to elect, on the first Monday of April next, and every two years thereafter, one additional justice of the peace, who shall hold his office in the town of Eddyville in said county.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect after its publication in the Demoiné Courier and Eddyville Free Press, provided that such publication shall not be at the expense of the State.

## CHAPTER 64.

## WAPELLO CITY.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the City of Wapello, in Louisa county, Iowa.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the* <sup>Powers of council.</sup> *State of Iowa,* That, in addition to the powers and privileges already conferred upon the council of the city of Wapello, they shall have the power to establish streets and alleys, and to vacate the same upon the petition of two-thirds the value of the real property on both sides of the street or alleys where the change is desired, but whenever the exercise of this power shall injure the property of any person, the corporation of said city shall be liable to the person so injured in such sum as may be adjudged proper by three disinterested persons, to be selected by the marshal of said city.

SEC. 2. The city council is invested with authority to <sup>Borrow mon-</sup> borrow money, for any purpose, not exceeding twenty thou-<sup>ey.</sup> sand dollars, and pledge the faith of the city for the payment thereof:—*Provided* the question of borrowing be first
