

CHAPTER 75.

FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

AN ACT to define the time of holding courts in the fourth judicial district.

Time of hold-
ing courts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the terms of court shall be held in the fourth judicial district as follows: In the county of Johnson, on the first Monday of March and June, and the second Monday of October;

In the counties of Linn and Benton as now provided by law;

In the county of Washington as now provided by law for the year 1857, and after the year 1857, on the third Monday of March and August, and the second Monday of November;

In the county of Iowa as now provided by law;

In the county of Tama on the first Tuesday after the third Monday of May, and on the first Tuesday after fourth Monday in October.

Time for trial
in Johnson and
Washington
counties.

SEC. 2. All pleas, process, proceedings, notices, suits, bills in equity, indictments, recognizances and criminal proceedings now pending, or returnable to the next term of said court, in Johnson and Washington counties, shall be returnable to, and tried at the next March term thereof, as provided herein.

Not to affect
suits pending.

SEC. 3. No dismissal or discontinuance of any civil action or criminal proceeding shall be had in consequence of this act, but all of the business of the said courts shall be disposed of in its regular order.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Republican and Iowa Capital Reporter.
