SEC. 3. That the expenses incurred in carrying into effect the foregoing sections, shall be paid out of the treasury of said county, on the order of the county judge. Expenses.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Republican and the Fairfield Ledger, which publication shall be without expense to the State.

CHAPTER 94.

SCHOOL DISTRICT.

AN ACT to organize School District No. 1, in Barclay township.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That James Barclay, of School District No. 1, in Barclay township, Blackhawk county, State of Iowa, be, and he is hereby authorized to give notice, by posting written or printed notices in at least five public places within said district, of the time and place of holding a meeting therein, for the election of district officers. Notice of election.

SEC. 2. The electors of said district, when assembled in pursuance of the aforesaid notice, shall have all the powers granted to electors when assembled in district meetings by section 1111 of chapter 69 of the code of Iowa. Powers of electors.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
