## CHAPTER 4

NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF PUBLIC OFFICERS

## S. F. 17

AN ACT relating to the nomination and election of public officers.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section forty-nine point thirty-one (49.31), Code 1962, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
"All nominations of any political party or group of petitioners, except as provided in section forty-nine point thirty (49.30) of the Code, shall be placed under the party name or title of such party or group, as designated by them in their certificates of nomination or petitions, or if none be designated, then under some suitable title, and the ballot shall contain no other names, except as provided in section forty-nine point thirty-two (49.32) of the Code.

In counties where two or more senators or representatives are to be elected to the general assembly at a general or special election the names of candidates shall be arranged and printed on the ballots in the following manner:

The county auditor shall prepare a list of the election precincts of his county, by arranging the various townships, towns and cities in the county in alphabetical order, and the wards or precincts in each city, town, or township in numerical order under the name of such city, town, or township. He shall then arrange the surnames of each political party's candidates for such offices alphabetically for the respective offices for the first precinct on the list; thereafter, for each political party and for each succeeding precinct, the names appearing first for the respective offices in the last preceding precinct shall be placed last, so that the names that were second before the change shall be first after the change. The procedure for arrangement of names on ballots provided in this section shall likewise be substantially followed in elections in political subdivisions of less than a county. In representative districts of two or more counties in which two representatives are to be chosen, each county auditor shall comply with the above requirements in his county."

SEC. 2. Section fifty point twenty-five (50.25), Code 1962, is amended by inserting in line one (1) of subsection six (6) after the word "Senators" the words "or representatives".
