CHAPTER 37

CAPITOL BUILDINGS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

S. F. 590

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements for buildings and grounds under the superintendent of public buildings and grounds.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state to the superintendent of public buildings and grounds the 2 sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00), or so much there-3 of as may be necessary, to be used in the following manner: 4 SEC. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following amounts: 1 Painting second (2nd) floor rotunda, interior of dome $\mathbf{2}$ 3 and grand stairway\$ 70,000.00 Replace deteriorated water pipes 4 40,000.00 Replace and recaulk all windows in main dome 5 7,500.00 6 Replace faulty steam lines and valves 15,000.00

 8 Cooling tower and piping 50,000.00
 9 Repair or replace roof of state laboratory and office
- 10 building ______ 10,000.00
- Grand total of all appropriations for all purposes for the biennium for capital improvements for buildings and
- 13 grounds\$200,000.00
 - SEC. 3. Before any of the funds hereinabove appropriated shall be expended, it shall be determined by the superintendent of public buildings and grounds, with the approval of the state architect and the executive council, that the expenditure shall be for the best interests of the state.
 - SEC. 4. Upon the completion of any project as set forth in this Act, any unobligated balance remaining may be used to supplement any other project as set forth in this Act or for such other repairs or projects needed, and to supplement any current or prior appropriations for repairs, improvements, replacements, alterations, and equipment for public buildings and grounds. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30, 1969, of the appropriation of this Act made by the Sixty-first General Assembly, shall revert to the general fund of the state.
