

## CHAPTER 98

## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

H. F. 266

AN ACT relating to the duties of members of the highway safety patrol and the clerical staff of the department of public safety.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty point four (80.4), Code 1966, as amended  
2 by chapter one hundred nine (109), section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-second  
3 General Assembly is hereby further amended as follows: By striking from  
4 lines eight (8) and nine (9) the words "inclusive of operators and chauffeurs  
5 license examiners".

1 SEC. 2. Section eighty point nine (80.9), Code 1966, is hereby amended  
2 by inserting in line seven (7) after the word "therein," the following: "when  
3 authorized by the commissioner of public safety".

1 SEC. 3. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred eighty-  
2 seven (321.187), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from line three (3) the words "highway patrol" and insert-  
4 ing in lieu thereof the words "members of the department".

5 2. By striking from line thirteen (13) the words "shall have the author-  
6 ity of", by striking lines fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) and by striking from  
7 line sixteen (16) the following "tion thereof, and".

CHAPTER 99

## BONDS FOR SAFETY DEPARTMENT AGENTS

H. F. 363

AN ACT relating to the bonding of employees of the department of public safety and special agents.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty point sixteen (80.16), Code 1966, is hereby  
2 repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:

3 "All special agents appointed by the commissioner of public safety pur-  
4 suant to section eighty point seven (80.7) shall furnish bond as required  
5 by the commissioner in the amount of five thousand dollars. All members  
6 of the state department of public safety excepting the members of the  
7 clerical force shall be bonded for the faithful performance of their duties,  
8 in such an amount as the commissioner of public safety may deem neces-  
9 sary, but not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for any one posi-  
10 tion, and clerical employees may be so bonded. The commissioner is autho-  
11 rized to purchase bond coverage with departmental funds, either in blanket  
12 bond form or in individual bond form or in any combination thereof."
