

CHAPTER 131
LIQUOR SHIPMENTS

H. F. 182

AN ACT relating to documents accompanying liquor shipments.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred twenty-five point sixteen (125.16),
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
3 1. By striking from lines seven (7) and eight (8) the words "labeled or
4 marked" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "identified".
5 2. By inserting after the word "shipper" in line eleven (11) the following:
6 " , or unless such information is shown on a bill of lading or other docu-
7 ment accompanying the shipment".

CHAPTER 132
AIR POLLUTION CONTROL COMMISSION

AN ACT relating to the time of election of the officers of the air pollution control commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred sixty-two (162), section three (3),
2 Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby amended by striking
3 from line fifty-one (51) the words "in each calendar" and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the words "following June 30 of each".

CHAPTER 133
CITY BOARD OF HEALTH

S. F. 199

AN ACT relating to city boards of health in certain cities.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred sixty-three (163), Acts of the Sixty-
2 second General Assembly, section seven (7), is repealed and the following
3 enacted in lieu thereof:
4 "The council of any city having a population of twenty-five thousand
5 or more, according to the latest federal census, may appoint a city board of
6 health in the manner specified in sections four (4) and five (5) of this chap-
7 ter or the council may appoint itself to act as the city board of health.
8 The city board shall have jurisdiction within the municipal limits."
