

CHAPTER 221

CERTAIN COUNTY HOSPITALS

H. F. 745

AN ACT relating to secretaries and treasurers of certain county hospitals.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section three hundred forty-seven A point one (347A.1),
 2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
 3 1. By striking from lines forty-six (46) and forty-seven (47) the words
 4 "during the month of November" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
 5 "no later than December first".
 6 2. By striking from lines forty-eight (48) and forty-nine (49) the words
 7 "and a secretary. The county treasurer shall be ex officio".
 8 3. By striking from line fifty (50) the words "treasurer of the board of
 9 hospital trustees" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 10 " , secretary, and treasurer. The secretary and treasurer shall each file
 11 with the chairman of the board a surety bond in such penal sum as the
 12 board of trustees requires, with sureties to be approved by the board of
 13 trustees, for the use and benefit of the county hospital. The reasonable
 14 cost of the bonds shall be paid from the operating funds of the hospital.
 15 The secretary shall report to the county auditor and the county treasurer
 16 the names of the chairman, secretary, and treasurer of the board as soon
 17 as practicable after the appointment of each. The treasurer of the county
 18 hospital shall receive and disburse all funds. Warrants shall be drawn by
 19 the secretary and countersigned by the chairman of the board after the
 20 claim has been certified by the board. The treasurer of the county hospital
 21 shall keep an accurate account of all receipts and disbursements and shall
 22 register all orders drawn and reported to him by the secretary, showing the
 23 number, date, to whom drawn, the fund upon which drawn, the purpose,
 24 and amount. The secretary of the board of hospital trustees shall file with
 25 the board on or before the tenth day of each month, a complete statement
 26 of all receipts and disbursements from all funds during the preceding
 27 month, and also the balance remaining on hand in all funds at the close
 28 of the period covered by the statement. Before the third Monday of each
 29 month, the county treasurer shall give notice to the chairman of the board
 30 of hospital trustees of the amount of revenue collected for each fund of the
 31 hospital to the first day of that month, and the chairman shall draw his
 32 draft therefor countersigned by the secretary, upon the county treasurer,
 33 who shall pay such taxes to the treasurer of the hospital, only on such
 34 draft."
