

## CHAPTER 329

## IOWA FAIR AND FOOD EXPOSITION

S. J. R. 24

A JOINT RESOLUTION to continue the "Iowa state fair and world food exposition study committee" established by the Sixty-first General Assembly, and to make an appropriation therefor.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Iowa have expressed interest in the state of Iowa serving as host for a world food exposition; and

WHEREAS, Iowa food producers, food processors, manufacturers of food processing, and related manufacturing and industry will benefit from a world food exposition; and

WHEREAS, the United States and the world could benefit from a properly planned and executed world food exposition; and

WHEREAS, the "Iowa state fair and world food exposition study committee" and expert resource persons studied during the Sixty-first and Sixty-second General Assembly interims the feasibility of Iowa hosting a world food exposition and have determined that a properly planned and executed world food exposition is feasible; NOW THEREFORE,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. The "Iowa State Fair and World Food Exposition Study  
2 Committee" established by the Sixty-first General Assembly is hereby  
3 continued, except that the members of the committee representing the  
4 General Assembly shall, after the effective date of this Act, include  
5 the president of the Senate, one senator appointed by him from a differ-  
6 ent political party, the speaker of the House and one member of the House  
7 appointed by him from the minority party.

1 SEC. 2. The committee is empowered to communicate with the feder-  
2 al government and others and to indicate the desire of Iowa citizens  
3 to cooperate with others, to communicate with private companies, public  
4 organizations, and others indicating the reasons for and advantages of  
5 having a world food exposition in Iowa. The committee is empowered to  
6 explore methods of developing a world food exposition and to do those things  
7 the committee deems advisable to sustain and increase interest in a world  
8 food exposition.

1 SEC. 3. The committee shall make a progress report and recommenda-  
2 tions to the second session of the Sixty-third General Assembly and to the  
3 Sixty-fourth General Assembly. All recommendations to be accompanied  
4 by bills, where necessary.

1 SEC. 4. There is hereby appropriated from any funds of the state not  
2 otherwise appropriated the sum of two thousand five hundred (2,500) dol-  
3 lars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of  
4 this Act.
