

CHAPTER 19.

COURT IN FT. MADISON.

AN ACT in relation to the time of holding Court in Fort Madison, Lee County, and providing for a special term of said Court for the purpose of trying Criminal Cases.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the next term of the District Court of Lee County, at Fort Madison, for the purpose of trying civil and criminal cases, shall be held on the second Monday in October, 1858.

SEC. 2. All civil causes set for trial at the March term, 1858, of said Court, shall be tried at the October term aforesaid, and all notices, writs, and all processes of every kind and nature whatsoever, which are now required to be returned to the March term, 1858, shall be returnable to the said October term, *Provided* the provisions of this Section shall not apply to criminal causes.

SEC. 3. A term of said District Court shall be held at Fort Madison on the second Monday in March, 1858, for the purpose of trying the criminal cases now pending in the said Court, or which may hereafter be commenced therein, but no cases other than criminal shall be tried at said term.

SEC. 4. So much of Chapter sixty-five of the Acts of the Sixth General Assembly of the State of Iowa, as conflicts with the provisions of this act is hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the "Gate City," "Keokuk Daily Journal," and "Fort Madison Plain Dealer." Approved February 20th, 1858.
