

notices required by this act only, shall be given, *Provided*, that the provisions of this act shall be construed to apply to all sales of real estate made under, or by virtue of any decree rendered by the Courts of this State.

SEC. 3. In all sales made by Constables, two weeks notice of the time and place of such sale shall be given by posting up three written or printed notices in at least three public places in the township where the judgment was rendered, and where the defendant resides; one of which shall be on the door of the Justice's office.

Notice of Constable's sale.

SEC. 4. Sections 1905 and 1906 of Chapter 110 are hereby repealed, and the foregoing shall take the place thereof.

CHAPTER 73.

BUTLER COUNTY.

AN ACT to annex the County of Butler to the tenth Judicial District, and prescribing the time for holding Courts therein.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That Butler County be, and the same is hereby attached to the tenth Judicial District.

Annexed to tenth District.

SEC. 2. The time for holding Court in said County shall be on the Thursday following the third Monday after the third Monday in May, and September, in each year.

Time for holding Court.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

Conflicting law repealed.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect from and after its publication in the Tri-Weekly Citizen and the Tri-Weekly Iowa State Journal.

Take effect.
