CHAPTER 86.

SENATORIAL APPORTIONMENT.

AN ACT to re-apportion the State into Senatorial Districts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* The ratio for the apportionment of the State into Senatorial Districts shall be one Senator for each seventeen thousand two hundred inhabitants, or fraction thereof exceeding one half in each Senatorial District. Ratio—17,200.

SEC. 2. The county of Lee shall constitute the first District and shall have two Senators. 1st Dist., 2.

SEC. 3. The county of Van Buren shall constitute the second District and shall have one Senator. 2d Dist., 1.

SEC. 4. The county of Davis shall constitute the third District and shall have one Senator. 3d Dist., 1.

SEC. 5. The county of Appanoose shall constitute the fourth District and shall have one Senator. 4th Dist., 1.

SEC. 6. The counties of Wayne and Decatur shall constitute the fifth District and shall have one Senator, and the votes for Senator in said District shall be returned to the county seat of Decatur county. 5th Dist., 1.
Canvass in Decatur.

SEC. 7. The counties of Ringgold, Taylor, Adams, Union and Clarke shall constitute the sixth District and shall have one Senator. The votes for Senator in the sixth District shall be returned to the county seat of Union county. 6th Dist., 1.
Canvass in Marion.

SEC. 8. The counties of Page, Fremont, Mills and Montgomery shall constitute the seventh District and 7th Dist., 1.

shall have one Senator; the votes for Senator in the seventh District shall be returned to the county seat of Mills county.

Can'vass in Mills. 8th Dist., 1. SEC. 9. The county of Des Moines shall constitute the eighth District and shall have one Senator.

16th Dist., 1. SEC. 17. The county of Keokuk shall constitute the sixteenth District and shall have one Senator.

17th Dist., 1. SEC. 18. The county of Mahaska shall constitute the seventeenth District and shall have one Senator.

18th Dist., 1. SEC. 19. The county of Marion shall constitute the eighteenth District and shall have one Senator.

19th Dist., 1. SEC. 20. The county of Scott shall constitute the nineteenth District and shall have one Senator.

20th Dist., 1. SEC. 21. The county of Clinton shall constitute the twentieth District and shall have one Senator.

21st Dist., 1. SEC. 22. The county of Cedar shall constitute the twenty-first District and shall have one Senator.

23d Dist., 1. SEC. 24. The county of Polk shall constitute the twenty-third District and shall have one Senator.

SEC. 26. The county of Jones shall constitute the ^{25th Dist., 1.} twenty-fifth District and shall have one Senator.

SEC. 27. The county of Linn shall constitute the ^{26th Dist., 1.} twenty-sixth District and shall have one Senator.

SEC. 28. The county of Dubuque shall constitute the ^{27th Dist., 2.} twenty-seventh District and shall have two Senators.

SEC. 29. The county of Clayton shall constitute the ^{28th Dist., 1.} twenty-eighth District and shall have one Senator.

SEC. 30. The county of Warren shall constitute the ^{29th Dist., 1.} twenty-ninth District and have one Senator.

SEC. 31. The counties of Madison, Dallas and Adair ^{80th Dist., 1.} shall constitute the thirtieth District and have one Senator, and the votes of said District cast for Senator shall ^{Canvassed in Madison.} be canvassed at the county seat of Madison county.

SEC. 32. The counties of Pottawattame, Cass, Har- ^{81st Dist., 1.} rison, Shelby, Audubon and Guthrie shall constitute the thirty-first District and have one Senator, and the votes cast for Senator shall be canvassed at the county seat of ^{Canvassed in Pottawattamie.} Pottawattamie county.

SEC. 33. The counties of Monona, Crawford, Car- ^{82d Dist., 1.} roll, Greene, Woodbury, Sac, Ida, Calhoun, Webster, Humboldt, Pochahontas, Buena Vista, Cherokee, Plymouth, Sioux, O'Brien, Clay, Palo Alto, Kossuth, Emmett, Dickinson, Osceola and Buncombe shall constitute the thirty-second District, and shall have one Senator, and the votes cast in said District for Senator shall be ^{Canvassed in Webster.} canvassed at the county seat of Webster county.

SEC. 34. The counties of Iowa and Powesheik shall ^{83d Dist., 1.} constitute the thirty-third District and have one Senator, and the votes cast shall be canvassed at the county seat of ^{Canvassed in Powesheik.} Powesheik county.

SEC. 35. The counties of Jasper and Marshall shall ^{84th Dist., 1.} constitute the thirty-fourth District and have one Senator, and the votes cast therein for Senator shall be ^{Canvassed in Jasper} canvassed at the county seat of Jasper county.

SEC. 36. The counties of Benton and Tama shall ^{85th Dist., 1.} constitute the thirty-fifth District and have one Senator, and the votes cast for Senator in said District shall be ^{Canvassed in Benton.} canvassed at the county seat of Benton county.

SEC. 37. The counties of Grundy, Black Hawk, But-
