Section 1. Be it enactal by the General Assembly of the State of Iomoa, That the Judge of the First Judicial dipered. District in the State of Iowa is hereby authorized and it is made his duty to hold a special term of the District Court in Keokuk, in Lee county, at such time as he may deem expedient betwreen the first day of April and first day of July of this year, for the trial of criminals, and for that purpose alone.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from rate croot. and atter its publication in the Iowa State Journal and the Iuwa Weekly Citizen.
