

Scott county. In the County of Scott on the first Mondays of February, May, August and November, in each year.

Clinton co. In the County of Clinton on the first Mondays of March, September and December in each year.

Jackson co. In the County of Jackson on the first Tuesdays after the fourth Mondays of March and September in each year.

Suits commenced not affected. SEC. 2. No suits, pleas, indictments or proceedings of any character, civil, criminal or special, shall be abated, quashed, discontinued or affected in consequence of the change of time of holding said Courts. All process issued at any time before the taking effect of this Act shall be considered as returnable to the first term of the Court in said Counties respectively, which shall be held next after the taking effect of this Act.

Process returnable.

SEC. 3. All Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 165.

WITNESS FEES.

AN ACT in relation to fees of witnesses.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That when any party has paid to a witness his fees and the same are afterwards collected from the opposite party, the person so paying the same, shall upon producing the receipt of the witness be entitled to such fee, whether in the hands of the Justice or Clerk, or has been paid into the Treasury as contemplated by Articles two and three in Chapter twenty-three of the Revision of 1860.
