1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 15.274 PROMOTIONAL PROGRAM FOR  
2 NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARKS.

3 The department of economic development, in cooperation with  
4 the state department of transportation and the department of  
5 cultural affairs, shall establish and administer a program  
6 designed to promote knowledge of and access to buildings,  
7 sites, districts, structures, and objects located in this  
8 state that have been designated by the secretary of the  
9 interior of the United States as a national historical  
10 landmark. The program shall be designed to maximize the  
11 visibility and visitation of national historic landmarks in  
12 this state through the use of, but not limited to, signage on  
13 highways, tourism literature, and maps of the state and  
14 cities. For purposes of this section, "highway" means the  
15 same as defined in section 325A.1.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill relates to the establishment of a promotional  
18 program for national historic landmarks.

19 The bill requires the department of economic development,  
20 in cooperation with the state department of transportation and  
21 the department of cultural affairs, to establish and  
22 administer a program designed to promote knowledge of and  
23 access to buildings, sites, districts, structures, and objects  
24 located in the state that have been designated by the  
25 secretary of the interior of the United States as a national  
26 historical landmark. The bill provides that the program shall  
27 be designed to maximize the visibility and visitation of  
28 national historic landmarks in the state.
