**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing an appropriation for the family development and  
2 self-sufficiency program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 249

1 Section 1. FAMILY DEVELOPMENT AND SELF-SUFFICIENCY GRANT  
2 PROGRAM. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
3 state to the department of human services for the fiscal year  
4 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006, the  
5 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be  
6 used for the purposes designated:

7 To be credited to the family investment program account and  
8 allocated for the family development and self-sufficiency  
9 grant program as provided under section 217.12, in addition to  
10 the other funding appropriated or allocated for this purpose  
11 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005:

12 ..... \$ 3,000,000

13 The amount appropriated in this section, when combined with  
14 other funding designated for the program for the fiscal year,  
15 is intended to restore the funding for this program to the  
16 level committed to this program in prior fiscal years.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides an FY 2005-2006 appropriation to the  
19 family investment program account administered by the  
20 department of human services and allocates the appropriation  
21 for the family development and self-sufficiency grant program.  
22 The bill states that the appropriation, when combined with  
23 other funding designated for the program for the fiscal year,  
24 is intended to restore the funding for this program to the  
25 level committed to this program in prior fiscal years.

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
