1 Section 1. GULF WAR VETERANS MEMORIAL -- PLANNING AND
2 CONSTRUCTION APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the
3 general fund of the state to the department of administrative
4 services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and
5 ending June 30, 2007, the following amount, or so much thereof
6 as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

7 To provide for the planning, siting, and construction of a
8 gulf war veterans memorial:

9 \$ 50,000

10 The capitol planning commission, in consultation with the
11 Iowa department of veterans affairs, is responsible for the
12 planning and siting of a gulf war veterans memorial on the
13 state capitol complex. The gulf war veterans memorial is
14 intended to commemorate those Iowans who died in operation
15 desert storm, operation Iraqi freedom, or operation enduring
16 freedom.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill appropriates \$50,000 to the department of
19 administrative services for the planning, siting, and
20 construction of a gulf war veterans memorial. The memorial is
21 to honor those Iowans who died in the first gulf war,
22 (operation desert storm), or during the current conflict in
23 Iraq (operation Iraqi freedom) or Afghanistan (operation
24 enduring freedom). The bill provides that the capitol
25 planning commission, in consultation with the department of
26 veterans affairs, is responsible for the planning and siting
27 of the memorial on the state capitol complex.
