RE: LSB # 5397 - An Act relating to the ability of the Division of Labor Services to service and collect debts owed to the Division.

This bill gives the Labor Commissioner the authority to delay or deny applications for licenses, commissions, registrations, certificates and permits for all Labor Division programs when the applicant owes a liquidated debt to the Labor Commissioner related to any of the Labor Division programs.

Under this bill, the Labor Commissioner could deny any or all of the following to an entity that owes liquidated debt: amusement ride licenses (Iowa Code 88A); boiler and unfired steam pressure vessel operating permits and/or special inspector commissions (Iowa Code 89); elevator operating permits and/or special inspector commissions (89A); boxing and wrestling licenses (91A); construction contractor registration certificates (91C); and employment agency licenses (94A).

This bill authorizes the Labor Commissioner to delay issuance or deny any of the licenses, certificates, or permits identified above to any entity or individual(s) who owe liquidated debt to the Labor Commissioner. The amount of the liquidated debt for unpaid fees, penalties, or settlement amounts is established by court adjudication, settlement agreement, and/or operation of law. This bill is seen as a measure that will allow to Commissioner to expedite collection of unpaid liquidated debt.
