A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring the department of education to study the sale of
2 carbonated beverages in schools.

1 Section 1. CARBONATED BEVERAGE SALES IN SCHOOLS -- STUDY.
2 The department of education shall conduct a study concerning
3 the sale of carbonated beverages to students in schools during
4 the 2005-2006 school year. The department shall require
5 school districts to provide information to the department in
6 records or reports required by section 283A.5 with respect to
7 school breakfast and lunch programs. The information to be
8 provided shall include the number of elementary, middle, and
9 high schools within each school district that sell carbonated
10 beverages to students, the method by which the carbonated
11 beverages are sold, the number of locations within each school
12 where the sales are made, the amount of carbonated beverages
13 sold on a per pupil basis, and the gross sales amount of such
14 carbonated beverages. The information shall not include sales
15 of carbonated beverages at extracurricular events.

16 On or before January 15, 2007, the department of education
17 shall file a report with the general assembly that contains
18 its findings and recommendations, including any proposals to
19 change or limit the sale of carbonated beverages in schools.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill requires the department of education to conduct a
22 study concerning the sale of carbonated beverages to students
23 in schools during the 2005-2006 school year. The department
24 shall require school boards to submit information about the
25 type and number of schools in each district that sell
26 carbonated beverages, the method by which the beverages are
27 sold, the number of locations within each school where the
28 sales are made to students, the amount of such beverages sold
29 on a per pupil basis, and the gross sales amount of such
30 beverages in each school district. The bill also requires the
31 department of education to file a report with the general
32 assembly on or before January 15, 2007, containing its
33 findings and recommendations.
