SC 276 NAT. RES. & ENVIRONMENT

1 Section 1. Section 123.53, Code 2005, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. The treasurer of state shall transfer  
4 to the grape and wine development fund established in section  
5 175A.5 a sum of money equal to five percent of the gross  
6 amount of wine sales made by the division from the beer and  
7 liquor control fund on a monthly basis.

8 Sec. 2. Section 123.53, subsection 4, Code 2005, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10 4. The treasurer of state, after making the ~~transfer~~  
11 transfers provided for in ~~subsection~~ subsections 3 and 3A,  
12 shall transfer to the division from the beer and liquor  
13 control fund and before any other transfer to the general  
14 fund, an amount sufficient to pay the costs incurred by the  
15 division for collecting and properly disposing of the liquor  
16 containers.

17 Sec. 3. Section 175A.5, subsection 1, Code 2005, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 1. A grape and wine development fund is created in the  
20 state treasury under the control of the department. The fund  
21 is composed of moneys appropriated by the general assembly and  
22 moneys available to and obtained or accepted by the department  
23 from the United States or private sources for placement in the  
24 fund. The fund shall include moneys deposited into the fund  
25 from the beer and liquor control fund as provided in section  
26 123.53, and from the wine gallonage tax as provided in section  
27 123.183.

#### EXPLANATION

29 This bill provides that the treasurer of state shall  
30 transfer on a monthly basis from the beer and liquor control  
31 fund to the grape and wine development fund established in  
32 Code section 175A.5 an amount equal to 5 percent of gross wine  
33 sale revenues. The amount transferred would be added to other  
34 amounts deposited into the fund and used to carry out grape  
35 and wine development programs as provided in Code section

1 175A.4.
