1 Section 1. Section 321.194, subsection 1, paragraph a,
2 subparagraph (1), Code Supplement 2005, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 (1) During the hours of 6 five a.m. to ~~10~~ eleven p.m. over
5 the most direct and accessible route between the licensee's
6 residence and schools of enrollment or the closest school bus
7 stop or public transportation service, and between schools of
8 enrollment, for the purpose of attending duly scheduled
9 courses of instruction and extracurricular activities within
10 the school district.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill addresses the hours when a person with a special
13 minor's license is permitted to operate a motor vehicle. A
14 special minor's license can be issued to a person between 14
15 and 18 years of age who does not qualify for an intermediate
16 license. The license allows the person to drive unsupervised
17 between home and school for the purpose of attending classes
18 and extracurricular activities during the hours of 6 a.m. to
19 10 p.m. The bill extends those hours to 5 a.m. to 11 p.m.
