A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing a supplemental appropriation for the low-income
2 home energy assistance program, and including an effective
3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION -- LOW-INCOME HOME
2 ENERGY ASSISTANCE. There is appropriated from the general
3 fund of the state to the division of community action agencies
4 of the department of human rights for the fiscal year
5 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006, the
6 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
7 used for the following purpose:

8 For supplementation of the low-income home energy
9 assistance appropriation made in 2005 Iowa Acts, chapter 164,
10 section 10, to be used to help eligible households meet home
11 energy costs in accordance with 2005 Iowa Acts, chapter 164,
12 section 10, subsection 4, and none of the following amount
13 shall be used for administrative expenses:

14 \$ 6,000,000

15 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill relates to the provision of energy assistance.
19 The bill provides for a supplementary appropriation to the
20 low-income home energy assistance program administered by the
21 division of community action agencies of the department of
22 human rights for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, in
23 the amount of \$6,000,000. The supplementary appropriation is
24 for energy cost assistance and not for administrative
25 expenses.

26 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
