Pursuant to Iowa Code section 17A.9A and 481 Iowa Administrative Code (“IAC”) 6, the Iowa Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) makes the following ruling on the Petition to Lift Reporting Requirements on previous waiver submitted by Walgreens Central Fill (“Petitioner”).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner has three stores, 21394, 21417, and 21426, with Iowa nonresident pharmacy license numbers 5543 (current and expires December 31, 2025), 5544 (current and expires December 31, 2026), and 5897 (current and expires December 31, 2025).
2. Petitioner previously obtained a waiver for all three stores from the requirements of 657 IAC 21.10(3)“b” (now found at 481 IAC 552.20(2)) which states:
 - a. Pharmacist verification of AMDS-dispensed drugs.
 - b. Except as provided in paragraph 552.20(3) “b”, a pharmacist will document final verification of any medication manipulated by the AMDS (such as counting or packaging) prior to dispensing to a patient.
3. Petitioner is specifically requesting to lift the quarterly reporting requirement that was part of the previously granted waivers in light of the fact that there have been no reportable issues since the waivers were originally granted.
4. The Board considered the Petition for Waiver at a board meeting on November 5, 2025.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the Request and the fact there have been no reportable issues or patient safety issues since the waivers were granted, the Board finds that the quarterly reporting requirement should be lifted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the Request to Lift the Reporting Requirement for all three store waivers is GRANTED.
