Re: Waiver request (HD-W- 26-09)

Dear Mr. Haroldson:

On June 22, 2026 IDALS received a waiver request of Iowa Administrative Code 21-62.15 for *Me Too Mo_TM005683* to register her colt born April 27, 2025 with Iowa Foaled Status. A post-foal inspection was not completed. The colt of *Me Too Mo*, foaled on April 27, 2025, requires a waiver to qualify with the Iowa Foaled Status.

As requested, you provided a notarized statement from your veterinarian, Dr. Travis Kingsley. Dr Kingsley indicated the foal was born to *Me Too Mo* on April 27, 2025 in Decorah, IA and an exam was performed on the foal on April 27, 2025.

The criteria for reviewing a waiver request are set out in Iowa Code Section 17A.9A(2). Upon petition of a person, an agency may in its sole discretion issue a waiver or variance from the requirements of a rule if the agency finds, based on clear and convincing evidence, all the following:

- The application of the rule would pose an undue hardship on the person for whom the waiver or variance is requested.
- The waiver or variance from the requirements of a rule in the specific case would not prejudice the substantial legal rights of any person.
- The provisions of a rule subject to a petition for a waiver or variance are not specifically mandated by statute or another provision of law.
- Substantially equal protection of public health, safety, and welfare will be afforded by a means other than that prescribed in the particular rule for which the waiver or variance is requested.

After consultation with Dr. Katie Rumsey, Assistant State Veterinarian, I find that the above criteria is met in this specific case.

Therefore, I hereby **grant the waiver** for the colt of *Me Too Mo* born April 27, 2025, which gives this foal the Iowa Foaled Status.
