641—31.5(17A,105,272C) Filing of petition. A petition for a waiver must be submitted in writing to the board as follows:

- **31.5(1)** *License application.* If the petition relates to a license application, the petition shall be made in accordance with the filing requirements for the license in question and submitted to the board's executive officer.
- **31.5(2)** Contested cases. If the petition relates to a pending contested case, the petition shall be filed in the contested case proceeding, using the caption of the contested case, and submitted to the board's executive officer.
