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657—15.10 (124,126,155A) Policies and procedures. Pharmacy policies and procedures, established, implemented, and complied with pursuant to rule 657—8.3(155A), shall address, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1. Controlled substances;
- 2. Formulary or drug list;
- 3. Stop orders;
- 4. Drug sample use and distribution;
- 5. Drug recalls;
- 6. Outdated drugs;
- 7. Patient records;
- 8. Inspection of drug inventories;
- 9. Adverse reaction reports;
- 10. Leave and release drugs;
- 11. Emergency/first dose drug supply;
- 12. Drugs brought into the facility;
- 13. Medication administration and records;
- 14. Drug compounding;
- 15. Sterile products;
- 16. Access to the pharmacy in the absence of the pharmacist;
- 17. Transfers of drugs between facilities and correctional pharmacies;
- 18. Transfers of prescription drug orders between correctional pharmacies;
- 19. Delivery of drugs;
- 20. Notification when a drug or device is not available;
- 21. Drug destruction within the pharmacy;
- 22. Return of unused drugs.
