657—23.17(124,155A) Accountability of controlled substances. Use of Schedule II controlled substances shall be documented. A committee or representative of the facility may also require that Schedule III, IV, or V controlled substances or any other drugs be accounted for on proof-of-use forms. Documentation shall include at a minimum:

- 1. Name of drug;
- 2. Dose;
- 3. Name of ordering prescriber;
- Name of resident; 4.
- 5. Date and time of administration to resident;
- 6. Identification of individual administering;
- 7. Documentation of destruction, return to the pharmacy, or other disposition of all unused portions of single doses including the signatures of two individuals, at least one of whom is a licensed health care professional. [ARC 3859C, IAB 6/20/18, effective 7/25/18]
