# 1846 Iowa Constitutional Convention Members

Iowa's second constitutional convention convened in Iowa City on May 4, 1846.

Iowa's second proposed constitution, adopted in convention on May 18, 1846, and adopted by the voters on August 3, 1846, by a vote of 9,492 to 9,036, was the constitution by which Iowa became a state. The constitution was accepted by Congress and approved by President James K. Polk and Iowa was admitted as the 29th state on December 28, 1846.
