IOWA DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS COVID-19 RESPONSE — JUNE 3, 2020

The lowa Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA) is providing <u>resources</u> for artists, cultural organizations, and small businesses, as well as an array of educational materials about lowa art, history, film, and culture, in response to COVID-19.

The DCA has distributed more than \$1.1 million in grants to Iowa cultural organizations that have been severely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Applications for the third round of grants from the newly created Iowa Arts and Culture Emergency Relief Fund closed May 26, 2020. Funding for the grants is provided by the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA), Arts Midwest, and the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH). Federal funding is through the Iova Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Iova Economic Security (CARES) Act. See the full list of Round 2 and Round 3 grant awards, which were announced on June 3, 2020.
