COVID-19 — IOWA CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND UPDATE (NOVEMBER 2020)

Fund Update. Iowa received \$1.250 billion in federal funds through the <u>Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and</u> <u>Economic Security (CARES)</u> Act on April 20, 2020. To date, \$1.9 million in interest earnings has been credited to the Fund. As of November 16, 2020, a total of \$1.170 billion has been transferred from the Iowa Coronavirus Relief Fund (ICRF) to various programs for addressing costs associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The current balance in the Fund is \$82.0 million.
