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REVENUE ESTIMATING CONFERENCE — OCTOBER 2022

Revenue Estimate. The Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) met on October 13, 2022, and increased the estimated FY 2023 net General Fund receipts by \$399.6 million compared to the FY 2023 adjusted March estimate.

Fiscal Year 2023. The October REC estimate for FY 2023 net General Fund receipts, including transfers, totals \$9.534 billion, a decrease of \$269.3 million (-2.7%) compared to actual FY 2022. The estimated changes include a decrease of 4.3% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 3.0% in gross sales/use tax, and an increase of 6.8% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2023 revenue projection.

Fiscal Year 2024. The REC established an estimate of \$9.594 billion for FY 2024. This is an increase of \$60.2 million (0.6%) compared to the revised FY 2023 estimate. The estimated changes include a decrease of 6.0% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 5.4% in gross sales/use tax, and a decrease of 2.4% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2024 revenue projection.
