SUBJECT: **ANNUAL RECYCLED PRODUCTS REPORT**

Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 8A.315 (formerly Chapter 18.18), the Department of Administrative Services is to report to the General Assembly progress on the purchase of recycled products and soy-based inks.

The first report refers to **soybean-based inks**. During the fiscal year 2008, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), DAS Information Technology Printing Unit required all sheet fed printing contracted be produced with soy-oil based inks. All web printing that is purchased is required to be produced with soy-oil based ink. We estimate that the total dollar value of printing processed through DAS Information Technology Printing Unit with soybean-based inks is nearly 2.0 (two) million dollars. The value of the ink is just a fraction of the total value of this printing. The only area in which soy-oil based ink is not used is on specialty printing by screen printing methods using ultra violet curing for specialty type items like pens, sportswear, and static cling decals. This type of printing accounts for less than 3% of all printing purchased by the State of Iowa.

The second report refers to **recycled products**. During the fiscal year 2008, the following **plastic bags** were purchased:

The definition of plastic garbage liners in the Iowa Code refers to bags with recycled content.

The purchase of **office products with recycled content** has become easier to document with the implementation of the State's Stockless Office Supply Program. In calendar year 2008, the percentage of products purchased with recycled content has been **21.18%**, with a total dollar value of **\$908,641.80**. The pricing of these products is comparable with the non-recycled products.
