Sac and Fox Settlement Education

Program Overview

The Department of Education receives a standing General Fund appropriation that is distributed to the tribal council of the Sac and Fox Indian Settlement. The appropriated funds are for the expenses of educating children residing in the Settlement on land held in trust by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States. These funds are in excess of federal moneys paid to the tribal council for educating the children and are to be used to enhance teacher salaries.

Funding

Beginning in FY 2012, the Department of Education has received an annual standing General Fund appropriation totaling \$100,000 for the Sac and Fox Indian Settlement. However, in general, the Settlement has received an annual appropriation of \$100,000 since FY 1998. Prior to FY 2012, funding was provided as follows:

- In FY 2011, an appropriation of \$90,000 from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund was provided in Chapter [1193](#), 2010 Iowa Acts.
- In FY 2010, an appropriation of \$100,000 was provided in Chapter [179](#), 2009 Iowa Acts.
- From FY 1988 through FY 2009, an allocation of \$100,000 from Phase II of the Educational Excellence appropriation was designated for the Sac and Fox Settlement.
