of the
LEGISLATIVE SERVICE COMMITTEE

August 15, 1973

The Legislative Service Committee met on August 14, 1973 and makes the following recommendations to the Legislative Council:

1. That Larry Burch be employed as a Legal Counsel by the Legislative Service Bureau commencing August 7, 1973 at a beginning salary of \$11,000.
2. That the plans for double decking the north and south wings of the Legislative Service Bureau area as submitted by Mr. Frank Bunker be approved, subject to the heating and air conditioning being properly coordinated with an overall plan for heating and air conditioning of the legislative areas of the State House.
3. That the heating and air conditioning of the legislative areas of the State House be planned and installed essentially as a single unit.
4. That personal interviews of twenty minutes each be set up for August 22, 1973 for the following candidates for Citizens' Aide: Douglas Carlson, Robert Eaton, Mrs. Adriana Greffenius, Richard Howe, Roger Iverson, Thomas Mayer, Max Smith, and Mrs. Beverly Stubbee.
