OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICE COMMITTEE

September 11, 1985

A Search Subcommittee of the Legislative Service Committee, consisting of Senator W. C. "Bill" Hutchins, Representative Del Stromer and Representative John Connors, was appointed to review the forty-four applications for the position of Legislative Service Bureau Director. The Search Committee met on August 27, 1985 and reduced this number to five applicants who were invited to Des Moines for personal interviews.

The Legislative Service Committee met on September 11, 1985, interviewed the five finalists, and makes the following recommendations to the Legislative Council:

- 1. That Mr. Donovan Peeters of Annapolis, Maryland be hired as Director of the Legislative Service Bureau at a salary of \$49,000, plus actual moving expenses_not to exceed \$2,000.
- 2. That upon acceptance of the position by Mr. Peeters, he be available to meet with the Legislative Council at their September 19 meeting, and that his travel expenses to return for that meeting be paid.
- 3. That Mr. Peeters will assume the position as Director of the Legislative Service Bureau on October 1, 1985.
