1 Section 1. Section 279.23, subsection 1, Code 2024, is 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *Oe.* If the contract provides for one or 4 more severance payments, a statement that the administrator 5 shall not receive such payments if the contract is terminated 6 as a result of the administrator being found guilty in a 7 criminal proceeding on a charge relating to the administrator's 8 official duties or a dereliction thereof for which the period 9 for appeal has passed, other than a proceeding regarding a 10 simple misdemeanor or a parking violation as defined in section 11 321.210.

Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to contracts antered into pursuant to section 279.23, or continued pursuant to section 279.24, on or after the effective date of this Act. EXPLANATION

16The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with17the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

This bill provides that if an employment contract between a school board and an administrator provides for one or more severance payments, the contract shall contain a statement that the administrator shall not receive such payments if the contract is terminated as a result of the administrator being found guilty in a criminal proceeding on a charge relating to the administrator's official duties or a dereliction thereof for which the period for appeal has passed, other than a proceeding regarding a simple misdemeanor or a parking violation.

28 The bill applies to contracts entered into or continued on or 29 after the effective date of the bill.
