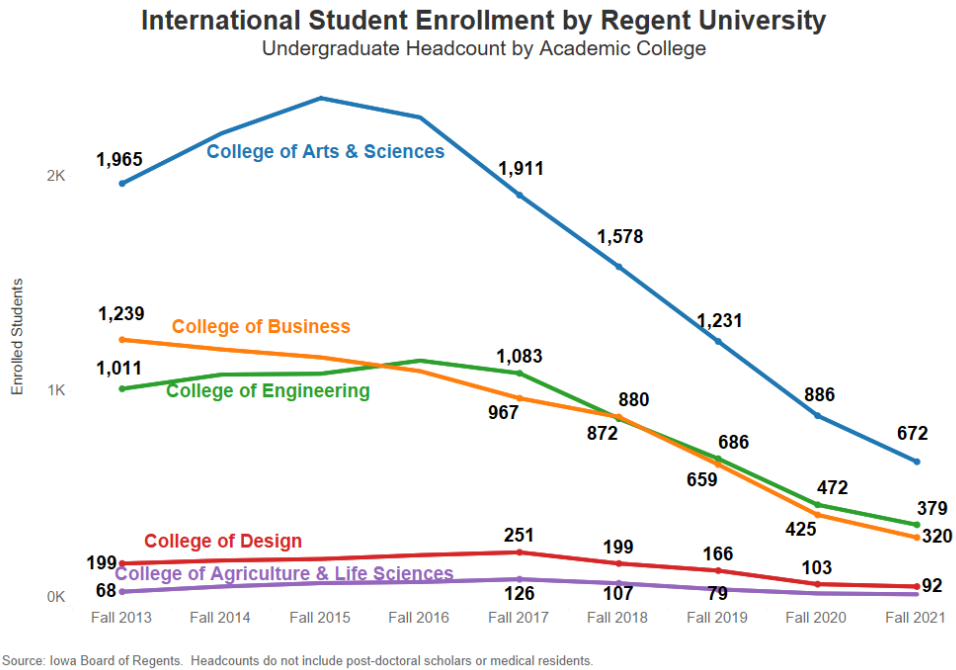
RE: Responses to committee follow-up questions during the March 28, 2022 International Relations Committee meeting.

Thank you for the opportunity this past Monday to present data on international student enrollment trends at the Regent universities. Below you will find responses to your follow-up questions:

- Into which majors/colleges are international students enrolling?
- Where do students from Iowa enroll in college overseas or study abroad?
- Have there been incidents on campus that would lead students and perspective students to feel unsafe at Regent universities?

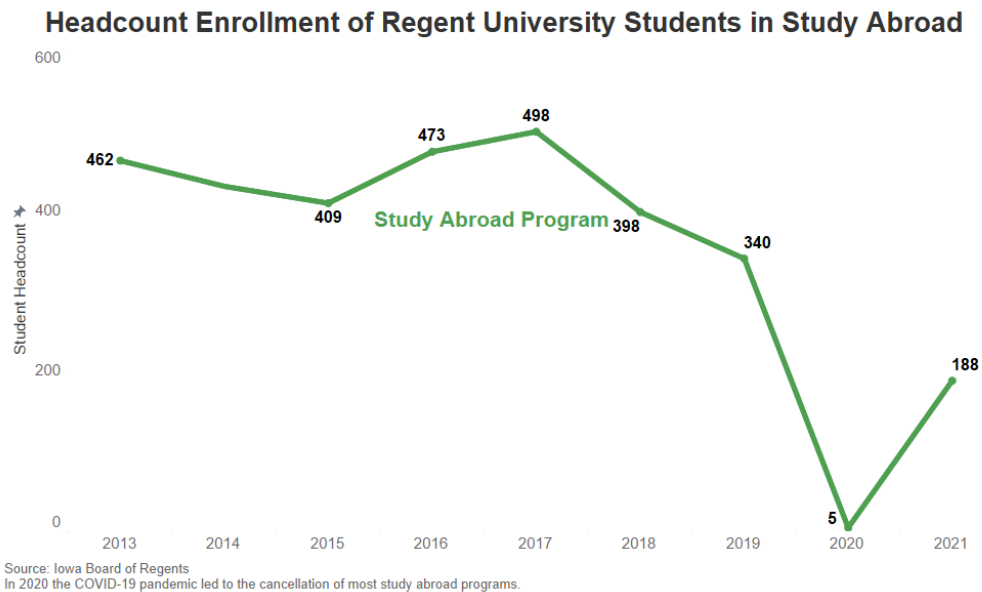
Question. Into which majors/colleges are international students enrolling?

Answer. It is difficult to look at individual majors, but the graph below shows trends by college at the Regent universities for international undergraduate students.



Question. Where do students from Iowa enroll in college overseas or study abroad?

Answer. The Regents do not have a way of tracking Iowa high school graduates who might leave the country for college. However, they can show the number of Regent university students who participate in Study Abroad programs. The top destinations for students from UNI are Spain, Italy, and Greece. The top destinations for students from Iowa State are Italy, United Kingdom, and Spain. The top destinations for students from the University of Iowa are Spain, Italy, and United Kingdom.



Question. Have there been incidents on campus that would lead students and perspective students to feel unsafe at Regent universities?

Answer. The number of reported hate crimes over the past three years is very low and has not increased over time. Below are links to complete campus crime statistics maintained by campus police as part of the Federal Clery Act.
