The Arc of East Central Iowa is about service, advocacy, inclusion, family, and community. They deliver high quality programs that produce results. More importantly, they improve the quality of life for individuals and families affected by disabilities including, but not limited to epilepsy, autism, Down syndrome, cerebral palsy, and brain injury. The Arc community is committed to building better lives for people with disabilities and their families.

The lack of comprehensive communication to affected individuals and organizations combined with an accelerated timeline have created serious concerns that the rollout of the Iowa Modernization Plan could negatively affect those served by the Iowa Medicaid System.
