#### INTRODUCTION OF GOVERNOR'S APPOINTEES

The Secretary of the Senate introduced to the Senate chamber John Benson, the Governor's appointee to be Director of the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. He was the guest of the committee on State Government.

The Secretary of the Senate introduced to the Senate chamber Gregory Samorajski, the Governor's appointee to be Chief Executive Officer of the Iowa Public Employees' Retirement System. He was the guest of the committee on Commerce.

The Secretary of the Senate introduced to the Senate chamber Matt Oetker, the Governor's appointee to be Chair of the Public Employment Relations Board. He was the guest of the committee on Workforce.

<u>House File 2625</u>, a bill for an act relating to the sales tax imposed on amusement devices.

Read first time and referred to committee on Ways and Means.

<u>House File 2637</u>, a bill for an act relating to the adoption tax credit available against the individual income tax, and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions.

Read first time and referred to committee on Ways and Means.
