The Senate met in regular session at 1:06 p.m., President Sinclair presiding.

Prayer was offered by the Honorable Mark Costello, member of the Senate from Mills County.

The Journal of Thursday, April 4, 2024, was approved.

## HOUSE MESSAGES RECEIVED AND CONSIDERED

The following messages were received from the Chief Clerk of the House:

MADAM PRESIDENT: I am directed to inform your honorable body that the House has on April 4, 2024, **concurred** in the Senate amendment **and passed** the following bill in which the concurrence of the House was asked:

**House File 2615**, a bill for an act relating to education, including by requiring community colleges to publish information related to graduates, requiring school districts to provide students enrolled in grades eleven and twelve with information related to graduates of community colleges and the average income and student debt of graduates of institutions of higher education governed by the state board of regents, and modifying provisions related to supplementary weighting.

ALSO: That the House has on April 4, 2024, **passed** the following bills in which the concurrence of the Senate is asked:

**House File 2679**, a bill for an act providing a deduction from the individual and corporate income taxes for the amount of certain income derived from indigent representation by an eligible law firm, and including retroactive applicability provisions.

Read first time and referred to committee on **Ways and Means**.

**House File 2680**, a bill for an act relating to public safety personnel retirement systems, the taxation of surviving spouse pension benefits, and including retroactive applicability provisions.

Read first time and referred to committee on **Ways and Means**.

The Senate stood at ease at 1:12 p.m. until the fall of the gavel.

The Senate resumed session at 1:18 p.m., President Sinclair presiding.

Senator J. Taylor introduced to the Senate chamber the Orange City Tulip Queen and her court.

The Senate rose and expressed its welcome.
